Led by former #1 World ranked doubles player, Dr. Scott Douglas, and supported by Coaches Frank Adams, Dean Oba, Kendall Chitambar, and the RMTC coaching team, RMTC is honored to host our first All Comers Tennis Camp (indoors in the RMTC bubble & outdoors at the University of Colorado Tennis Complex with good weather.) "All Comers" welcomes all athletes with physical disabilities, kids and adults alike. Open to 20 adults and 20 juniors, we hope to help players of all levels, from beginners to performance tournament players, play a ton of tennis, get a great work out, and develop their games.

Players will train two sessions per day: skill, movement, technical and tactical development each morning; points and match play development each afternoon. Adults are encouraged to play the RMTC Fall Adult Wheelchair Tennis Open or continue in the camp, Saturday and Sunday, October 22nd and 23rd. Juniors will play the camp and we'll finish with an in-house team event tournament for less experienced players and the option to play the RMTC Fall Adult Wheelchair Open for the more experienced players.
